BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

(B M P s)

EVERYONE MUST COMPLY

- 1. **ALL BOTTOM PAINT PREP WORK MUST BE PERFORMED BY SEAVIEW BOATYARD PERSONNEL.**
- 2. **WETSANDING AND/OR SCRUBBING OF BOTTOM PAINT IS EXPLICITLY PROHIBITED**
- 3. Painting procedures for "do-it-yourselfers": All paint cans, brushes, rollers, roller trays, etc. must be in a containment tray. Paint cans must be sealed at all times and may not be left open during job.
- 4. Grinding and power sanding operations must be **contained by tenting and performed with approved vacuum sander (no fugitive dust)**. Please see yard store for necessary tenting material and clean-up equipment. **DO NOT HOSE DOWN STALL.**
- 5. Boat stalls must be swept or vacuumed daily.
- 6. No spray painting or sand blasting
- 7. If stripper is used, visqueen must be spread to capture all residue
- 8. Discharge of gray water, bilge water and ballast water is prohibited.
- 9. Oil, anti-freeze, solvents, contaminated fuels and waste water must be disposed of properly - to arrange for disposal contact:
